To provide free or subsidized medical relief to the poor, needy, downtrodden and economically backward sects of people through outreach programmes. Help those in need of eyesight, who don't have near and dear to take care, who can't make it to a hospital on their own.

# **History of Pammal Sankara:**

- There was a need for quality education and health care.
- Blessed by His Holiness Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam
- Sri Sankara Vidyalaya started in 1983 with LKG to 5th standard, with 130 students.
- Supported by Rotary Club of Meenambakkam, under their theme "Discover a New World of Service".
- Sri Sankara Health Centre was established at Pammal and started the outpatient clinic in December 1984.
- M/s. Appaswamy Real Estates gifted 26 thousand sqft land at Sri Sankara Nagar in 1988 for the construction of the hospital building.
- A 20 bed general hospital was commissioned in 1990 with the funds generated through Rotary Club's efforts.
- To cater to the needs of general medicine, maternity and surgery.
- The hospital was upgraded to 60 beds in April 1993.
- His Holiness Sri Sankara Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam launched the Kannoli-Vision Saver Project of Rotary Club of Madras Fort in December 1994.
- Thus, Eye care became a part of this general hospital.
- This hospital was converted into an exclusive ophthalmic hospital from April 1999
- To provide comprehensive high quality eye care especially to the rural poor in the districts of Kanchipuram, Tiruvallur, Chennai and Chittoor (AP).
- Reaches out to those who are in need by providing service at their doorsteps through outreach programmes.

#### **Activities:**

Sankara Eye Hospital is, an ISO 9001:2008 certified, a non-profit charitable organization catering mainly to the needs of rural poor and needy. The hospital is established at Pammal, a Municipality in Kancheepuram District on the outskirts of Chennai City, about 6 K.M. from Meenambakkam Airport.

KANNOLI is a rural outreach program on eye care with a thrust on villages around Chennai, Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur & border Districts where the core of the activities of the mission is centered. Camps are conducted in the villages every day, screen the village folk for any ailments of Eye and identify the people who need surgical correction. These persons are brought to the base hospital at Pammal where the necessary surgery with Intra Ocular Lens (IOL) is performed with the best postoperative care absolutely FREE OF COST.

The hospital performs 50 cataract surgeries daily. The patients are admitted one day before surgery and discharged the day after. They are reviewed at their village itself within 10 days & again after one month. They are then issued with reading glasses.

After having successfully implemented the project of curable cataract blindness for the past one decade, giving vision to **more than one lakh thirty six thousand people**, the hospital has now focused on tackling the irreversible blindness and other complications arising from diabetes. The hospital is in a position to handle this massive project through the camp facilities already established by the hospital in all rural cataract screening centres.

The hospital has also established specialties like Glaucoma, Vitreo Retinal (medical & surgical), Paediatric Ophthalmology, Eye Banking, Keratoplasty (Corneal Transplant) and free transport available from Pallavaram to the hospital at Sarathi Kalyana Mandapam, opp .to Singapore Shoppe.

### Performance:

During the last ELEVEN years, the hospital has performed **more than ONE lakh THIRTY SIX thousand FREE** cataract surgeries covering a population of more than **ONE** crore.

The hospital conducts regular eye camps every day in Kanchipuram, Thiruvallur, Chennai & Chittoor (AP) districts. Presently, the hospital performs, on an average, **50** cataract surgeries per day.

The Vitreo Retinal Department was established in June 2006 and the surgical activity started in January 2007.

Pammal Sankara Eye Bank was established on June 29, 2008. The bank retrieved **82** corneas of which were utilized **22** for corneal transplantation at Pammal. **10** corneas have been transferred to Sankara Eye Hospital, Coimbatore, Bangalore & Shimoga and the same have been utilized by them, thus 39% corneas have been utilized. Dr.Srinivasa Rao, a Cornea Specialist joined as a visiting Consultant on 02.01.2010, which helps us to perform more corneal transplantation.

We have incurred a total expenditure of Rs.353.13 lakhs, against our revenue of Rs.355.87 lakhs during the year.

We have long term Fixed Deposits of **Rs.293 lakhs** and short term deposit of **Rs.20 lakhs** as on 31.03.2010.

To upgrade the Hospital Information System, we have procured one IBM SERVER with original operating system and increased the RAM capacity of all the computers at a total cost of Rs.1,26,350/-. The server has been installed in a separate air-conditioned cubical.

- ✓ Lions Clubs International District 324 A6 has donated one new Maruti Omni worth Rs.2.50 lakhs on July 18, 2009 for the transport of patients, doctors & staff.
- ✓ through M/s.Give India, we are able to receive Rs.2,44,317.74 funds

- ✓ certificates for seven Ophthalmic Assistant students (VIII batch) were distributed on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2009 at Kanchipuram blessed by HH Jagadguru Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal.
- ✓ a new 160KVA generator at a cost of Rs.9.50 lakhs was procured, installed & commissioned on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2009 for uninterrupted power supply.
- ✓ the hospital has participated in Chennai Marathon run on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2009 and propagated on Eye Donation.
- ✓ the hospital had a stall on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2009 at Chennai Trade Centre
  and publicized our activities.
- ✓ exgratia was given to all the doctors & staff as per the hospital norm.
- ✓ Diabetic Retinopathy screening camp was conducted in our hospital on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2009 on the eve of World Diabetic Day.
- ✓ M/s.ESSAR has donated Rs.8.61 lakhs on January 11, 2010 for procurement of one Tempo Traveller for the transport of patients, doctors & staff.
- ✓ Sightsavers International has gifted one Optical Coherence Tomography costing Rs.33 lakhs and one BIOM costing Rs.10 lakhs to strengthen our Vitreo Retinal Department. The equipments were commissioned on February 12, 2010.
- ✓ the hospital has remodeled 37 toilets to arrest water leakage on the
  walls & ceiling at a cost of Rs.7 lakhs.
- ✓ the hospital has redone the entire flooring of second floor ward at a cost of Rs.3.50 lakhs.
- ✓ the hospital has taken a colour / white washing interior & exterior of our building at a cost of Rs.7 lakhs, after arresting the seepages. The interior work is over and the exterior painting is in progress.

✓ the A/C plant with Heppa filter for the first floor theatre was commissioned in February 2010.


